



Master of Letters in Old Testament: Language Track (Part-Time; Semester Basis)

Coursework required for M.Litt. students studying on a part-time, semester basis is identical to coursework required for M.Litt. students studying on a part-time, annual basis or those studying full-time. However, in this modality students take only two core classes at a time, and attend shorter (one-week) residencies every six months.

M.Litt. students who wish to pursue an Old Testament concentration on the language track will take the following classes. Please note: language classes are offered on an ongoing basis with students from multiple cohorts participating together, and operate on a unique calendar. Students receive a total of 72 credit hours.
