

Master of Biblical and Theological Foundations

This degree, while similar to our Master of Letters program, only requires 54 credit-hours for graduation. Though students in the Master of Biblical and Theological Foundation program complete all sixteen courses in the Tennent core, as well as the field practicum, they are not required to complete a thesis or the biblical languages sequence. This allows for a slightly lighter load, generally 12 hours per term.

The Foundations degree is most suitable for those who want to broaden their theological foundation, desire to serve in general ministry leadership roles (lay or vocational), have an earned undergraduate degree, and want to pursue advanced theological education without the thesis or language requirements.
